

Sales Tax Rates

Cities population 10,000 or greater

Local Sales Tax Rates—effective 1/1/2014

37 Kansas cities with a population > 10,000, per 2010 census

32 Kansas cities with a pop. > 10,000 have a base sales tax **higher** than Winfield

2 Kansas cities with a pop. > 10,000 have a base sales tax **lower** than Winfield

2 Kansas cities with a pop. > 10,000 have a base sales tax **tied** with Winfield

If the 0.4% local sales tax passes, there would be 31 cities with a higher sales tax and 5 cities with a lower sales tax than Winfield
