Highland, Union/Graham and St. Mary's Cemeteries

- Memorial Day decorations will be permitted from May 22 - June 5, 2017. Decorations placed before May 22nd, or left after June 6th will be removed and disposed of by cemetery personnel.
- Artificial flowers and other decorations will be permitted in the grass from November 1st to April 1st.
- All artificial flowers and other decorations placed in the grass and on foundations will be disposed of beginning April 1st to prepare for the upcoming mowing season (April 1st – November 1st).
- The concrete foundation around the headstone/monument/marker is a mowing flange and should not be used for decoration purposes. Items found on the mowing flange will be removed and disposed of by cemetery personnel.
- Artificial flowers are allowed in approved display fixtures year-round. Deteriorated flowers will be disposed of without notice.
- Toys, statues (concrete or otherwise), unsightly objects, glass jars, glass vases, porcelain trinkets, stakes and wires, tin containers, and unapproved containers including concrete planters will not be allowed as grave decorations. Such items will be removed and disposed by cemetery personnel without notice.
- New ornamental rock, landscape timbers, fences, and borders or edging of any kind are prohibited.
- Planting of trees, shrubs, and rosebushes are prohibited. Unauthorized plantings will be removed and disposed by cemetery personnel.
- All live flower plantings must be within six inches of the headstone foundation. Plants must be removed from the container and planted in the ground.
- Only one shepherd's hook will be allowed per space and placed so as not to interfere with cemetery maintenance or pose a safety hazard to the public or cemetery personnel.
- Benches must be pre-approved by the cemetery sexton. Certain restrictions apply.
- Pets shall not be allowed to run at large in any cemetery. Leash laws are in effect.
- Before finalizing monument plans or starting any improvement projects please contact the cemetery sexton for approval of plans and designs.
